The Global Network Architecture – Technical Working Group welcomes participation from network architects and engineers from R&E networks around the world. We hold 2-3 face-to-face meetings each year, usually in conjunction with other meetings and usually alternating between a US and non-US location.

The GNA Technical WG work between the face-to-face meetings takes place in an occasional video conference and on the mailing list. Versions of working documents are stored in a folder on Box.com.

We have a minimal set of expectations for participants. Meeting these simple expectations will allow for the most beneficial and productive meetings

- 1. You make every attempt to attend the meetings. This will require financial support from your organization, as the GNA Technical WG has no funds for this purpose.
- 2. Prior to the meeting, you should have read all the documents relevant to the meeting. An agenda will be published prior to the meeting.
- 3. At the meeting, you participate actively and respectfully in the items being discussed.
- 4. When volunteers are called on a topic of interest to you, you offer to assist.
